An Information Travel Guide and a short narrative.

Science

We will be looking at the needs of different animals, including humans, their needs and life and growth cycles. Within this, we will also be learning about healthy habits for life: exercise, hygiene and diet.

Art

We will be looking at colour, shape and patterns, particularly as designs for hot air balloons. Children will initially explore pattern using a variety of media and then use creative skills to create their designs, which will then be made into a collage.

Maths This term, we will start understanding the number system, exploring the relationship between numbers, with a focus on place value and fluency. This will include counting in groups. Then we will move onto understanding what happens when we add and subtract numbers; using this understanding to solve problems and develop our reasoning skills. Finally, we will learn about Multiplication and Division, once again applying our understanding to solving problems and reasoning.

DT

We will be exploring mechanisms in particular wheels and axles. Children will learn how wheels and axles can be fixed a vehicle and factors that may impact on their effectiveness.

History

We will learn about the history of transport, the inventors who have had an impact on its development and comparing types of transport now and then.

Music

The children will learn seasonal songs and perform them in our school Christmas nativity.

Geography The children will use world maps, to identify the United Kingdom, its countries and capital cities. They will also identify where the UK is in relation to other countries and continents of the world. The children will take part in a field work block linked to the topic of transport, conducting an investigation and analysing their findings using tables and charts.

PE

We will be completing a 'Get Set 4 PE'. In this unit pupils will develop the fundamental skills of balancing, running, changing direction, jumping, hopping and skipping. Pupils will be given opportunities to work with a range of different equipment.

R.E We will be exploring the units "Who is a Muslim and how do they live?" and "Why does Christmas matter to Christians?"

Computing

We will learn about E-safety and how to keep our personal information safe online. We will then focus on learning about computing and IT around us and how it all works.

PSHE We will be learning about "Being Me in My World" and "Celebrating Difference". Children will learn about worries and fears, rights and responsibilities and contribute to their class charter.
