English: Autumn Poems, Ordinary People Who Changed the World, Stig of the Dump

In the first half of the term we will be reading a range of poems and then, taking on board the time of the year, we will be writing our own autumnal poems. Then in collaboration with our history topic, Inspirational Figures of the Past, we will be writing biographical fact files. During the second half of the autumn term we will be reading Stig of the Dump. During our analysis of the class novel, we will focus on how writers create effective setting descriptions and we will write our own book reviews to share with other children in our book corners.

Maths

This term, we will study the number system in depth. First, we will revisit place value, then we will develop more advanced mental and written methods for addition and subtraction. Finally, we will learn more about Multiplication and Division.

Computing

This term in computing children will be learning to programme, focussing on sequencing sounds. In addition, we will be delivering E-safety lessons.

History

This unit we will be studying influential people who have an impact on society today. This will culminate with children conducting their own research on an influential person from history.

Art

This unit will link to History. We will research and imitate the patterns styles to create cave paintings. We will focus on the detail and meanings behind the images chosen.

Science

Our first Science unit will be 'Animals Including Humans'. We will explore the purpose of skeletons, find out how muscles work and learn about the importance of healthy eating. After that, we will investigate 'Forces and Magnets' through scientific enquiry.

Geography

Through this unit, we will be learning about what a settlement is and recognising the features in our own environment. We will also be developing children's map reading skills.

DT

During this unit, we will be making direct links with History and Art - by creating a hold bag for Stone Age tools focussing on stitching.

French

During this unit, the children will learn ten animal names and the verb I can.

PE

This term we will be learning how to communicate, collaborate and compete with each other through a variety of physical activities.

Music

The children will start by learning how to sing in harmony and learn the language of music through instruments.

R.E

Children will re-visit the story of Creation, why things go wrong in the world, and explore forgiveness. Children will study the story of Noah and consider "Promises".
