# Spring Term Plan Year 5

## Key events

## English - Letters from the Lighthouse and Once

In English this term, we will be looking at texts linked to World War Two. Children will focus on grammar, punctuation and spelling to write a character description, a diary entry, a newspaper report and a setting description.

## Maths

This term children will be looking at multiplying a 4-digit number by a 2-digit number as well as short division. We will then look at fractions, decimals and percentages. They will then move on to perimeter and area measuring and calculate the area of different shapes. Finally, children will be looking at statistics, interpreting graphs and data.

## French

This term in French, the children will learn basic vocabulary linked to talking about family and looking at the habitats in which animals live.

## History

The children will question, research, investigate and produce information on a range of topics and areas of life during World War II. Topic areas such as rationing, shelters, woman at work, propaganda, life on the front line, the Blitz, evacuation, the Holocaust and important leaders.

## R.E

Children will explore why Christians believed that Jesus was the Messiah. Then in the second term, they will learn why the Torah is so important to Jewish people.

## Science

Properties and Changes of Materials: We will be investigating the changes of state that occur when heating and cooling solids, liquid and gases.

Living Things and their habitats: Children will learn about the life cycles of flowering and non-flowering plants. They will also look at the life cycles of humans and a bird to begin.

## Geography

Children will be using maps and atlases to locate places that were affected by WWII, identifying countries that were involved.

## DT

We will be researching, designing and making a 3D model of an Anderson shelter that will be used to form part of an exhibition based on WWII.

## PE

This term children will learn skills in Handball for one of their sessions. The other unit we will be looking at is Dance.

## Music

The children will continue their third term of Taiko drumming.

## Art

Children will be looking at Monotypes. Monotypes is the process of transferring ink from one surface to another to make a single print.
